On Line Consent for trips

After last years successful roll-out of the SCO On Line Payment system, we are now looking to incorporate On Line Parental Consent as well. We have trialed this with our Year 5's for a recent school trip and it is proving very successful. Going forward you will be able to give Parental Consent for your child to take part in a school trip at the same time as completing payment via the on line SCO Pay system. This will remove the need to return the permission slip. Within the online consent section there is a comments section where you will be able to provide emergency contact details, offer to help or add any comments that you may have. Trip letters will still come home in the usual way, via your child's book bag. As we are looking at ways to reduce the paper that we send home to parents we may review this in the future.

If you do not currently have an SCO pay account we will be issuing the sign up letters over the next couple of weeks. Whilst we are looking at ways to save paper we are also looking at ways to make things more convenient for parents. On line payments means that you can make payments via the comfort of your own home at a time that suits you.
